The traffic diverter test period will conclude and the diverter will be removed on Tuesday, January 2nd, 2018. Additional traffic data will be collected by City Traffic Engineering after the test diverter is removed. A possible, permanent diverter will be discussed at city meetings, open to public comment, under the following schedule:

Tuesday, March 20th--Introduction at Common Council

Tuesday, March 27th—Pedestrian, Bicycle & Motor Vehicle Commission

Wednesday, April 18th—Board of Public Works

Tuesday, May 1st—Final approval at Common Council

If the permanent diverter is approved by the Common Council, construction will take place during the North Blair Street reconstruction project in the summer of 2018.
