Areas of concern: Stop signs and the BB Lapham School bikes and peds on the sidewalk Lapham School after school – cars and kids Livingston between Galaxie and the Constellation and at the bike boulevard Not enough light on Mifflin. Paterson between E. Washington and Mifflin with the Festival Food traffic Dayton and Ingersoll intersection is dangerous for school kids. Blair and Mifflin at the end of the work day is hard on bicyclists with the cars turning onto Blair. Worry that changes diverting cars from Mifflin will cause Dayton St. to get too busy.

Some ideas:

Parking on both sides of Mifflin. Crossing guard for Lapham Traffic diversion on Mifflin Street Traffic humps to slow cars down. Better signage on the bike boulevard Better signage at Festival Foods entry and exit. Make Mifflin a one-way for cars and two-way for bikes Garden circles in the intersections. Bump-outs Four-way stops Flagged crossing at Dayton/Ingersoll
